All applications must be accompanied by a nonrefundable \$5 processing fee when submitted to the membership chairman. The application will be read to the club members at the first two meetings in which the applicant is present and will be voted upon at the second reading.

Dues will be payable upon a candidate's notification of election to membership. Those who join between January 1 and June 1 will be responsible for a full year's dues. Those who join after June 1 will be responsible for a half year's dues.

NOTE - all membership applicants must be sponsored by two YCKC members. If applying for active membership status, you must attend two regular meetings or one membership meeting and assist at a minimum of one club-sponsored event after submitting the application and before the application can be acted upon.

#### **CLASSIFICATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP** AND DUES

□ **REGULAR** – Welcome at the club's monthly business meetings and encouraged to be a working participant in at least one club activity and function per year. Entitled to vote, hold office, and receive club awards. Dues are \$15 per year.

□ HOUSEHOLD – Available to households consisting of two adults, with or without children under 18, residing under one roof. Welcome at all meetings and club functions. Entitled to one vote per adult over 18; may hold office and receive club awards. Dues are \$20 per year.

ASSOCIATE – Available to individuals and households. Welcome at meetings and club functions. Encouraged to be a working participant in a club activity. Cannot vote or hold office and not eligible to receive club awards. Dues are \$20 per year for Associate Individual or Associate Household.

□ JUNIOR – Open to individuals who are 10-17 years of age. At the end of the calendar year in which they attain their 18th birthday, Junior members must apply for membership as Active or Associate members. Dues are \$10 per year.

YCKC is licensed by the American Kennel Club and is governed by its rules and regulations.
